

know that every cat needs vetting — a considerable expense when taking in a cat or kitten including spay/ neuter, testing for FELV/FIV, all vaccines, and costs for any other medical issue needing attention — and all this must be done at a cost of \$170/cat/kitten before allowing them into our cageless environment.

So what should Lemon's owner have done?

- Ask for help. Talk with someone at H.A.L.O. We have a waiting list. We could also help with a simple courtesy FB post to help rehome.
- Ask friends and family to help temporarily in what seems to be a desperate situation.
- Make phone calls to all rescues for help or advice.
- Provide pet responsibility until arrangements can be made. Never abandon an animal!
- Always consider your situation and pet expense before getting a pet as a lifetime commitment. Lemon is currently on antibiotics for dental issues. We are hopeful this will fix her ailment. If not, she will need to have her teeth extracted.
